

### New England Unit Teaching Herb Garden Allium Collection

Common Name	Botanical Name	Hardiness	Height	Comments
Yellow Onion	<i>Allium flavum</i>	Z 4	24"	Yellow flowers. Blooms in July. Plant in clusters for best effect.
Turkestan Onion	<i>Allium karataviense</i>	Z 4	10-12"	Broad leaf; Light pink, sweet scented flowers in May.
German Garlic	<i>Allium senescens</i>	Z 5	24"	Flat leaves. Forms clumps. Blooms before garlic chives. Light pink flowers.
Curly Chives	<i>Allium senescens 'Glaucum'</i>	Z 4	9"	Curly foliage main attraction. Light purple flowers in summer.
Fall Blooming Onion	<i>Allium thunbergii 'Ozawas'</i>	Z 4	24"	Purple flowers. Blooms in October.
Garlic Chives	<i>Allium tuberosum</i>	Z 3	12"	Culinary plant. Flat leaves. White flowers. Blooms in August.
